Asher Arnon is an interdisciplinary creator artistically active in the intersection of visual, spatial and sound-oriented arts, with an academic and professional background in visual communications, architecture and urban culture, art, and music. Arnon's creative work spans a wide range of design-oriented and artistic projects in diverse formats. In recent years, his practical and theoretical research has focused on exploring possibilities for place representation through interrelations between image and music and the notion of 'sense of place', emphasising the experience-interpretation continuum manifested by orientation through spatial-visual-sonic artefacts.

Arnon is a retired Professor of Creative Arts at Bezalel Academy of Arts and Design in Jerusalem, Israel.
